- ⇒ **Community Health Indicators:** local, state, and national data covering everything from smoking to obesity rates.
- ⇒ **Library:**
  - ⇒ Medical articles on a large variety of medical conditions.
  - ⇒ Articles are updated regularly.
  - ⇒ List of interactions and side effects of medications.
  - ⇒ Descriptions of various medical tests and procedures.
  - ⇒ A comprehensive list of contact information for local and national support groups for a variety of health concerns.
  - ⇒ Interactive quizzes and calculators to help you learn more about your health.
  - ⇒ A symptom checker that helps you discover the cause of your symptoms.
- ⇒ **Links:** to local, state, and national government agencies and non-profit organizations.
- ⇒ **Legislate:** Contact your legislators and track current health related legislation
- ⇒ **My Personal Health Record (My PHR):** create a personal login and track your medical information. Prescriptions, medical conditions, tests, treatments, and legal documents can all be stored in a secure environment and in one convenient place.
